PRIORITY WILL BE GIVEN TO CURRENT KAWANANAKOA MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENTS AND THOSE THAT ENROLLED FOR SY 19-20

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE:

Registration will start on Monday, April 15 through Friday, May 3, 2019.

1. Complete the application form and submit to KMS Main Office, Monday through Friday from 8:00 AM – 4:00 PM.
2. U.S. mailed applications should be marked: *ATTN: SUMMER PROGRAM DIRECTOR*
3. All applications MUST be signed by a Parent/Guardian.
4. Full Tuition payment MUST accompany the application form. DO NOT mail cash.

Please write checks payable to "Kawananakoa Middle School"

NOTE: Pursuant to Act 45, SLH 1981, the Department of Education will assess a fee of \$25 (cash) for each returned check.

5. Class confirmation will be emailed/sent home with students after the registration period.
6. Receipts will be sent home with students the first week of Summer School: Wednesday, June 12 – Friday, June 14.

TUITION WAIVERS:

There are no tuition waivers available at this time from the Department of Education. However, Alu Like has a Native Hawaiian Summer School Assistance Program which offers tuition assistance on a first-come-first-served basis. REFUNDS:

- 100% Refund – for Withdrawal prior to the start of summer school, BEFORE 4:00 PM Monday, June 10, 2019.
- 50% Refund – for Withdrawal on the 1st day of Summer School, BEFORE 4:00 PM Wednesday, June 12, 2019
- **NO REFUNDS after June 12, 2019**

MEAL SERVICE:

There will be **NO lunch** served during Summer School this year. Students may bring their own snacks/food to eat in the Cafeteria. Students may **NOT** leave campus to purchase lunch/food. No food will be sold on campus.

ATTENDANCE:

Absences: One (1) Summer School day is more than the equivalent of approximately a week of the regular school session. Therefore, attendance is important and will be addressed on a daily basis. Two (2) unexcused absences will result in IMMEDIATE dismissal and/or failure with **NO REFUND**. Family trips or sports event trips will not be considered excused.

Reporting an Absence:

1. A telephone call from Parent / Guardian to the KMS Office by 8:00 AM on the day of the absence.
2. A note from Parent / Guardian to the teacher indicating the reason and date(s) of absence(s) on the first day the student returns to Summer School.

Tardies:

Students need to be punctual and be in school on time. Students with unexcused tardies will make up time missed with the Summer School Director AFTER SCHOOL. Students arriving tardy thirty (30) minutes or more will be considered absent for the day.

DISCIPLINE:

Summer School will follow the discipline guidelines for the Department of Education Chapter 19. A student may be dropped from the program (with no refund) if s/he does not demonstrate the commitment, responsibility, and respectful behaviors needed to make this Summer School program successful.

REPORT CARDS:

Will be given to each student on the last day of Summer School. Students will earn either a "Satisfactory" or "Unsatisfactory" grade for Enrichment Courses.

PERIOD 1: 8:00 AM - 9:55 AM

PERIOD 2: 10:05 AM - 12:00 PM

Transition to Middle School

Instructors: Mr. Flatt, Mr. Baron

Enrollment Open to: Incoming 6th Graders

Course Description: Students will be given an orientation to the Kawanauakoa Middle School campus, school expectations, and procedures. Grade 6 lessons in the 4 core areas: English, Math, Science, and Social Studies; plus Physical Education will be covered.

Arts & Crafts

Instructor: Ms. Ikezawa-Ishida

Enrollment Open to: All students

Course Description: Here's your hands-on fun time with friends! Students will make-and-take-home various creative arts and crafts projects including Origami, Bead Crafts, Lanyard-Flexlace, and Drawing.

Math Enrichment 7

Instructor: Mr. Toyama

Enrollment Open to: **ONLY incoming 7th grade students**

Students will be given the opportunity to review Math concepts covered in the previous 6th grade year and be introduced to concepts that will be covered in the upcoming 7th grade year. No math credit will be given for this course.

Orchestra (Period 1 Class Only)

Instructor: Mr. Mew

Enrollment Open to: **ONLY** current KMS students who have completed 1 quarter of Orchestra class

Course Description: Learn how to play the violin, viola, cello, or bass. Summer School String Orchestra is an enrichment class that is offered to those who have had some previous music training. This course will cover: (Music) note reading in various clefs, rhythmic development, and understanding, intonation, how to play and perform on the violin, viola, cello, or string bass, and/or to improve current abilities on these instruments.

Speech (Period 1 Class Only)

Instructor: Mrs. Turbeville

Enrollment Open to: All Students

Course Description: Do you want to improve the way you deliver oral projects in your classes? It doesn't matter if you are outgoing or shy. This class will help you overcome stage fright and develop public speaking skills while having fun.

Beginning Band

Instructor: Mr. Lum

Enrollment Open to: All students. No previous music experience required.

Course Description: Students will develop fundamental performance skills on a woodwind, brass or percussion instrument in a group setting. They will develop ensemble skills and knowledge of music theory and music history. Instruments will be loaned to students for use during summer. Consumable supplies such as method books, mouthpieces, reeds, cleaning swabs, sticks, mallets, and valve oil may be purchased in class or students may provide their own supplies. Please consult with the teacher before purchasing any supplies.

Intermediate Band

Instructor: Mr. Lum

Enrollment Open to: Students with 1-2 years of experience playing on a woodwind, brass, or percussion instrument in a classroom setting.

Course Description: Students will further develop fundamental performance skills, ensemble skills, music theory, and music history. Instruments will be loaned to students for use during summer, but students must provide their own consumable supplies such as method books, mouthpieces, reeds, cleaning swabs, sticks, mallets, and valve oil. Please consult with the teacher before purchasing any supplies. Students must have teacher approval (See Mr. Lum) before registering for the course.

P.E. & Fitness

Instructor: Mr. Okano

Enrollment Open to: All students.

Course Description: Students will strengthen physical movement forms, concepts, principles, and skills through participation in a variety of physical activity experiences. Skills include the application of combinations of movement forms (chasing, fleeing, dodging, jumping and landing) and manipulative skills (dribbling, kicking, punting, throwing and catching) in complex changing situations. Students will be introduced to specialized sport-specific skills in modified versions of invasion, target, net and field activities. Sport activities could include, but are not limited to, the following: basketball, ultimate frisbee, speedball, handball, soccer, and weight training.

Health & Nutrition

Instructor: Mr. Miura

Enrollment Open to: All students.

Course Description: This course is designed to assist students in obtaining accurate information, developing lifelong positive attitudes and behaviors, and making wise decisions related to their personal health. The study of and activities will include personal and community health; mental, emotional, and social health; injury prevention and safety; nutrition and physical activity; alcohol, tobacco, and other drugs; growth, and development. Central themes are the acceptance of personal responsibility for lifelong health, respect for and promotion of the health of others, an understanding of the process of growth and development, and informed use of health-related information, products, and services.
