REGISTRATION PROCEDURE:

Registration will start on Monday, April 15 through Friday, May 3, 2019.

1. Contact your child's school counselor.
2. Complete the application form and submit to KMS Main Office, Monday through Friday from 8:00 AM – 4:00 PM.
3. All applications MUST be signed by a Parent/Guardian.
4. Class confirmation will be emailed/sent home with students after the registration period.

INSTRUCTIONAL DATES:

First day of instruction: Wednesday, June 12, 2019

Last day of instruction: Wednesday, July 10, 2019

HOLIDAY NON-INSTRUCTIONAL DAY:

Thursday, July 4 - Independence Day (NO SCHOOL)

TUITION: FREE

MEAL SERVICE:

There will be **NO Snacks/Lunch** served during the CREDIT RECOVERY program this year. Students may bring their own snacks/food to eat in the Cafeteria during recess/break. Students may **NOT** leave campus to purchase lunch/food.

ATTENDANCE:

Absences: One (1) CREDIT RECOVERY program day is more than the equivalent of approximately a week of the regular school session. Therefore, attendance is important and will be addressed on a daily basis. Two (2) unexcused absences will result in **IMMEDIATE DISMISSAL**. Family trips or sports event trips will not be considered excused.

Reporting an Absence:

1. A telephone call from Parent / Guardian to the KMS Office by 8:00 AM on the day of the absence.
2. A note from Parent / Guardian to the teacher indicating the reason and date(s) of absence(s) on the first day the student returns.

Tardies:

Students need to be punctual and on time. Students with unexcused tardies will make up time missed with the CREDIT RECOVERY Program Director AFTER SCHOOL. Students arriving tardy thirty (30) minutes or more will be considered absent for the day.

DISCIPLINE:

CREDIT RECOVERY will follow the discipline guidelines for the Department of Education Chapter 19. A student may be dismissed from the program if s/he does not demonstrate the commitment, responsibility, and respectful behaviors needed to make this CREDIT RECOVERY program successful.

REPORT CARDS:

Will be given to each student on the last day of the CREDIT RECOVERY program. A letter grade will be given for Credit-Recovery classes.

These classes are offered **only** to current KMS students in the 6th, 7th, or 8th grade who earned an "F" in a core subject course.

ENGLISH: Grades 6, 7, & 8

Enrollment Open to: KMS students who failed English

Course Description: Students will work with an instructor and online programs to successfully demonstrate proficiency in grade level English skills which include listening, speaking, reading, and writing.

MATH: Grades 6, 7, & 8

Enrollment Open to: KMS students who failed Math

Course Description: Students will work with an instructor and online programs to successfully demonstrate proficiency in grade level mathematical skills such as arithmetic, geometry, measurement, and problem-solving.

SCIENCE: Grades 6, 7, & 8

Enrollment Open to: KMS students who failed Science

Course Description: Students will work with an instructor and online programs to successfully demonstrate a proficient understanding of grade level Science concepts and content: Grade 6 – Physical Science, Grade 7 – Biological Science, Grade 8 – Earth and Space Science.

SOCIAL STUDIES: Grades 6, 7, & 8

Enrollment Open to: KMS students who failed Social Studies

Course Description: Students will work with an instructor and/or online programs to successfully demonstrate proficient understanding of Social Studies concepts and content: Grade 6 – Study of World Cultures and History from Ancient Times to the Renaissance, Grade 7 – History of the Hawaiian Kingdom / Pacific Island Studies, Grade 8 – Study of Post-Revolutionary America through Reconstruction.
